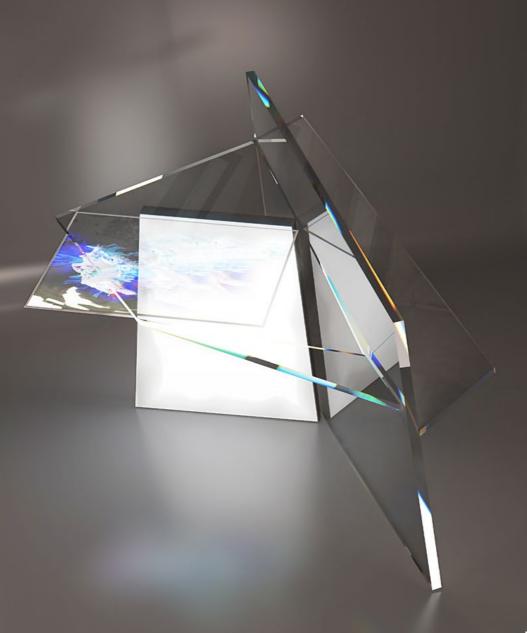
# 郑重宾 | 行影支离 ZHENG CHONGBIN WALKING PENUMBRA

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#### INTRODUCTION

INK studio Beijing is proud to announce a major solo exhibition entitled *Walking Penumbra* for California- and Shanghai-based artist Zheng Chongbin. Opening on Saturday March 24 on the occasion of Gallery Weekend Beijing 2018 and running through May 27, 2018, the exhibition for the first time presents the artist's multi-disciplinary practice—including his newest video and immersive light and space installation, his acrylic and video installations and a selection of his most recent paintings—as an integrated exploration of our living material world and how we, as conscious perceiving beings emergent with and within this world, construct ourselves and our reality.

Centrally featured in the 11th Shanghai Biennale, Zheng's 2016 installation *Wall of Skies* confronted its viewer with an imposing crystallized ink wall in a perception-shifting non-rectilinear white space. As sequel and counterpoint to this acclaimed installation, *Walking Penumbra* places its viewers in an inchoate black space of layered shadow, skylight, moving image, and sound. By transiting through the space, the viewer continuously discovers and recovers his or her position and orientation in relation to a kaleidoscopic flux of images and sensations.

The embodied experience of light and shadow have functioned as central metaphors throughout the history of philosophy from Shakyamuni Buddha's "Shadow Cave" to Plato's "Cave of Shadows." Only Zhuangzi, however, makes the *penumbra*—the luminous border between light and shadow—his central image for our existence; it being at once entirely without autonomy or independent existence and yet entirely self-realizing and self-so within its own experiential context.

Alongside *Walking Penumbra*, Zheng Chongbin will also exhibit *Actant Memories*, a new series of translucent acrylic and video sculptures derived from the artist's solo exhibition at the Yoshio Taniguchi-designed Asia Society Texas

Center, Houston in November 2017. Here, freestanding sculpture mediates a homologous spatial play of image, light, shadow and penumbra.

Finally, in its third-floor galleries, INK studio will showcase Zheng Chongbin's latest abstract paintings. In development since the early 1980's, Zheng's painting practice employs, in combination with the medium and language of ink, the visual language of geometry—specifically the natural geometry of fractals, the Euclidean geometry of human design, and the abstract, mathematical topology of continuous spaces—to reveal the living material world in its unfolding, dynamic engagement with embodied human experience.

Central to my practice is the pre-modern Daoist concept that the natural, inorganic world of energy and matter is living and always changing. If this is the case, how do we attune our perceptions to produce knowledge of this ever-changing world? How are we changed by our phenomenological (perceptual) entanglement with the phenomena (events) of the world? In turn, how do we, through our engagement with the world, actively create-transform ourselves and the world's being and becoming?

Unlike Western philosophers, who tended to embrace an ontology consisting of objects and categories, the pre-modern Chinese saw the world as made up of processes in flux—chaotic flows of matter and energy that came into transient coherent order and then dissipated. Today, this process-based worldview undergirds contemporary mathematics and scientific inquiry, from chaos theory to ecology, as well as philosophical discourses such as post-humanism and new materialism. Through geometry, space, light, moving image, material, and process, my work places these different worlds in dialog as human experience. —Zheng Chongbin, 2017

#### 展览介绍

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墨斋荣幸地呈现常驻美国加州与中国上海的艺术家郑重宾的全新个展——《行影支离》。展览将于画廊周北京期间的 2018 年 3 月 24 日开幕,并持续至 5 月 27 日。本展览将首次呈现郑重宾的跨学科艺术实践,涵盖他最新创作的影像装置和探索光与空间的沉浸式装置,以及最近完成的绘画作品。这种实践全面探索了我们所生活的物质世界,并深度研究了人类在这个世界里与天地万物共同生长的同时,如何建构我们自己和我们所理解的真实。

郑重宾在 2015 年第 11 届上海双年展中的装置作品《层层天墙》在一个挑战感官现实的非矩形空间里打造了一面坚实而厚重的墨墙。《行影支离》将延续并挑战《层层天墙》的概念与形式,在一个漆黑的混沌空间里交错叠加阴影、自然光、影像与声音。当观者在这个空间中穿行时,能够不断发现他们所处的位置、方向与周围万花筒般干变万化的图像和感知之间的关系。

以光影的涉身体验为核心的隐喻一直贯穿于哲学的发展历程中,比如柏拉图的"洞穴之影"与佛教的"影窟"。而只有庄子将闪烁于光影之间的"半影"视为人类存在的核心——虽然它本身毫无自主性和独立存在性,但在其自身的经验主义语境下,它又是一个能够完全实现自我的个体。

在本展览中,郑重宾还将展示他最新创作的一组由半透明丙烯和影像组成的装置作品《物忆》,延续了他于 2017 年 11 月份在谷口吉生设计的亚洲协会德克萨斯中心(休斯顿)举办的个展。它将有形的雕塑与无形的图像、光影和半影相互交融,在空间里形成灵动而跳跃的图景。

墨斋的三层展厅将呈现郑重宾近期的抽象绘画。自80年代起,郑重宾的绘画创作不仅探索水墨作为媒材和表达方式的可能性,而且运用几何学的视觉语言——尤其是自然界中的几何不规则碎片形、人体构造中的欧几里得几何,以

及连续空间中具有抽象性、数学性的拓扑学——来彰显物质世界与人类经验的动态交汇。

"我的创作一向秉承着古代道家思想的概念:自然而无机的能量和物质世界是一场循环往复的流变。如果事实是这样,那么我们应该如何调节自身的感知以在不断改变的世界中创造新的知识?我们又是如何在与这些现象性、感官性事件的纠缠之中被改变的呢?同样地,我们在世界中的参与又如何创造并影响自己与世界上的其它生命呢?

与遵循本体论中的对象和类别的西方哲学家不同,古代中国人眼中的世界处于一种无尽的变幻之中——物质和能量的无序流动在某一时刻瞬间凝聚成列,又在下一时刻消失殆尽。如今,这个基于过程的世界观遍布于当代数学、科学的研究,从混沌理论到生态学,甚至出现于后人文主义与新唯物主义等哲学讨论里。通过对几何、空间、光影、影像、材料和过程的探索,我的创作在这些不同的世界与人类经验之间建立对话。"(郑重宾于 2017 年)



#### **BIOGRAPHY**

b. 1961 in Shanghai, lives and works in San Francisco and Shanghai

Throughout his career of three decades, Zheng Chongbin (b. 1961, Shanghai) has held the classical Chinese ink tradition and Western pictorial abstraction in productive mutual tension. Systematically exploring and deconstructing their conventions and constituents—figure, texture, space, geometry, gesture, materiality—he has developed a distinctive body of work that makes the vitality of matter directly perceptible. Central to Zheng's art is the notion of the world as always in flux, consisting of flows of matter and energy that repeatedly cohered and dissipated. Inherent in pre-modern Chinese and especially Daoist thought, this worldview enables contemporary inquiries into complex systems like climate and social behavior, artificial intelligence, and quantum physics. Through the interactions of ink, acrylic, water, and paper, Zheng's paintings generate and record the processes that underlie the emergence of order (including organic life and human consciousness) and its inevitable dissipation. His paintings thus resemble natural structures ranging from neurons, blood vessels, and tree branches to mountains, rivers, and coastlines, but by instantiating their formation rather than by objective depiction.

Maintaining his commitment to painting, Zheng Chongbin has extended his conceptual explorations into the media of installation and video. His landmark light-and-space installation *Wall of Skies* (2015) consists of a complex folded structure fully enclosed by a tilted ceiling and slanted walls, creating a delicate interplay of nonparallel lines and planes. Resolving neither into painting, nor sculpture, nor pure light and space, it insists on its material presence even as its objecthood is dissolved in a spatial experience. In his video installations, Zheng represents processes of nature—from molecular and cellular to topographical and climatic—in the scale of human perception through microscopic and macroscopic imagery and accompanying soundscapes, unfolding these processes spatially and temporally.

Zheng Chongbin was educated as a classical Chinese figurative painter at the elite China Academy of Art in Hangzhou, where he taught for four years after graduation in 1984. Acclaimed as one of China's preeminent young experimental ink painters in the 1980's, he mounted his first solo exhibition at the Shanghai Museum of Art in 1988. In 1989, he received a fellowship from the San Francisco Art Institute to study installation, performance, and conceptual art, receiving his MFA in 1991. A resident of the San Francisco Bay Area for over three decades, Zheng is inspired by the region's distinctive atmospheric and environmental effects and rich ecologies, as well as by the California light and space movement.

In recent years, Zheng Chongbin has been recognized by a growing number international curators and institutions. In 2015, Zero Movement scholar Renate Wiehager exhibited Zheng's White Reflection (2012) with a work by senior German artist Max Uhlig at Daimler Contemporary in Berlin. Zheng debuted his environmental video installation, Chimeric Landscape (2015), at the European Cultural Centre's exhibition "Personal Structures" during the 2015 Venice Biennale. M+, under the direction of Lars Nittve, former founding Director of the Tate Modern, acquired eight works that document the development of Zheng's practice since the 1980's. In November 2015, the Los Angeles County Museum of Art began to feature the recently-acquired *Turbulence* (2013) in a two-artist presentation of Zheng and Roy Lichtenstein. In March 2016, the Metropolitan Museum of Art finalized its acquisition of *Unfolding Landscape* (2015) and the Brooklyn Museum its acquisition of Skylines (2014), both major abstract paintings by the artist. For Wall of Skies, Zheng was selected one of eleven highlighted artists by curators Raqs Media Collective at the 2016 Shanghai Biennale "Why Not Ask Again"?

Zheng's work can be found in the collections, among others, of the British Museum, the Los Angeles County Museum of Art, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Asian Art Museum of San Francisco, the Orange County Museum

of Art in California, the Brooklyn Museum, the Philedelphia Museum of Art, M+ in Hong Kong, the Daimler Art Collection in Stuttgart, Germany, the DSL Collection in France, and the Marina Bay Sands in Singapore. Zheng is the subject of a documentary film, The Enduring Passion of Ink, and an indepth monograph Zheng Chongbin: Impulse, Matter, Form, edited by Britta Erickson and distributed by D.A.P. in the United States.

艺术家简介

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#### 1961年生于中国上海,现在美国旧金山和中国上海生活和工作

在郑重宾三十年的艺术生涯,他融通中国传统水墨和西方抽象绘画,在系统地研究和分析了形象、质感、空间、动势、材料、几何形态这些东西方绘画所共有的基本要素后,郑重宾的作品使人直观地接感到物质的生命力。郑重宾最核心的艺术观念认为世界并不是静态的物质或类别的组成,而是一场永恒的流变,物质和能量在其中生灭往复。这个世界观是中国古代思想,尤其是道家思想的延续,它也成就了当代科学对于气候和社会行为等动态复杂系统、人工智能、量子物理等领域的探索,更衍生了程序艺术和大地艺术等当代艺术形式。通过墨、丙烯、水和宣纸的相互作用,郑重宾的作品表现的是秩序(包括有机生命和人类意识)的生成及其不可避免的消解。他不做客观性地描绘,而是借助材质和自然动能,让类似神经元、血管、树枝、山脉、河流、海岸线等的结构自然生成。

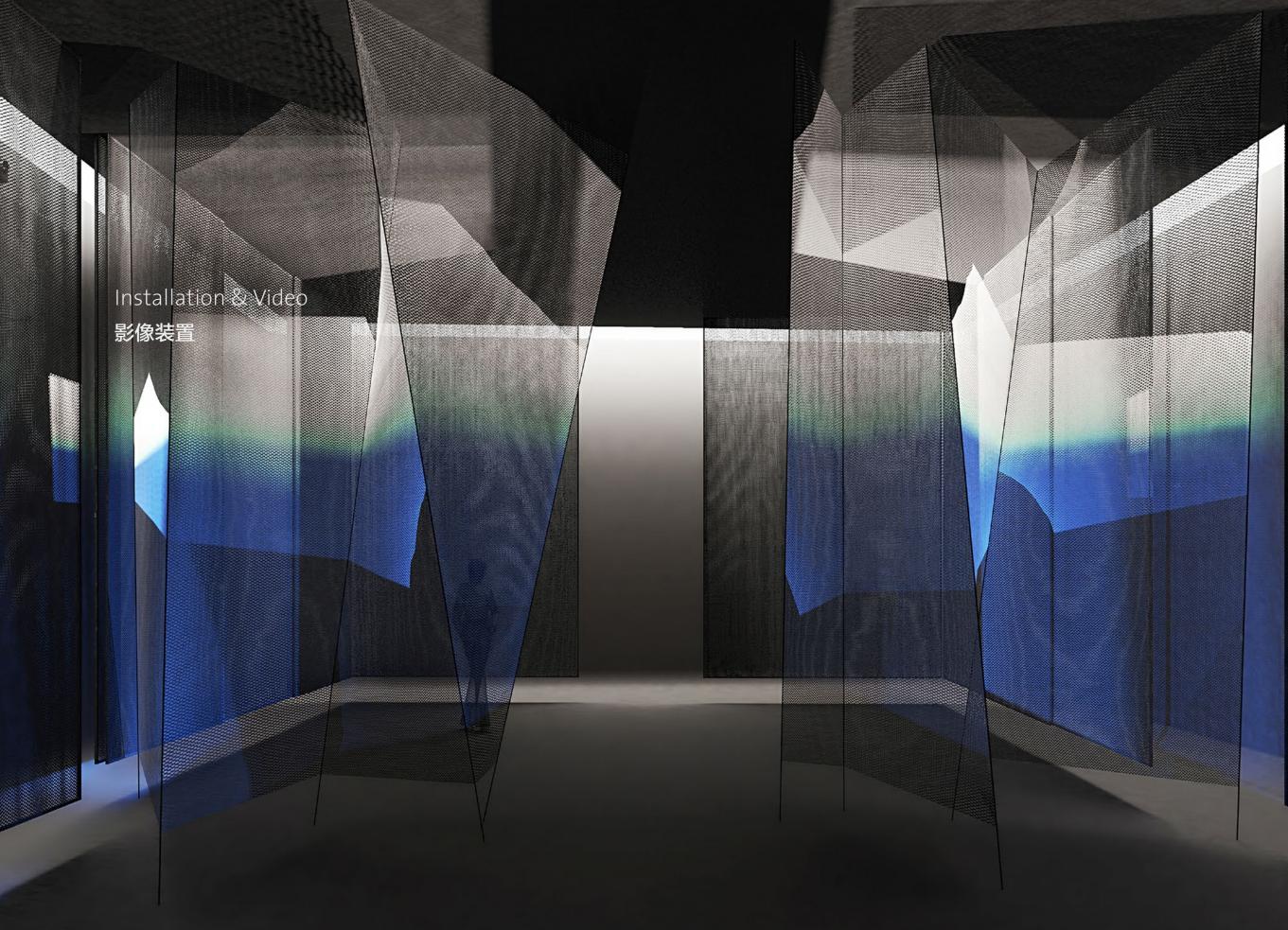
如今,在全心投入绘画创作的同时,郑重宾也将其具有探索性的观念引入装置和影像领域。郑重宾标志性的作品《层层天墙》是一件综合运用光与空间的装置作品,它以多重折叠的方式装裱而成,镶嵌于倾斜的天花板与墙面之间,营造出非平行的线与面之间微妙的张力。绘画、建筑、光、空间被揉合在一起,体现出纯粹的物质感,而这一物质感最终也将化为对空间的体验。在环境影像作品中,郑重宾以或微观或宏观的图像,以及相应的音效,表现小到分子、细胞,大到地形、气象等在时空中的自然演变过程。

郑重宾曾在杭州中国美术学院接受过传统的人物画学习,并于 1984 年毕业后留校任教。上世纪八十年代,他就被广泛地认为是一位年轻而卓有成就的实验水墨艺术家。1988 年,他在上海美术馆举办了第一次个人展。 1989 年,他获得旧金山艺术学院的奖学金,远赴重洋学习装置、表演以及观念艺术,

1991年获得该校艺术硕士学位。之后,郑重宾在旧金山湾区生活了三十多年。 美国良好的生态环境和自然气候,以及加利福尼亚的光与空间运动对他的艺术产生过很多影响。

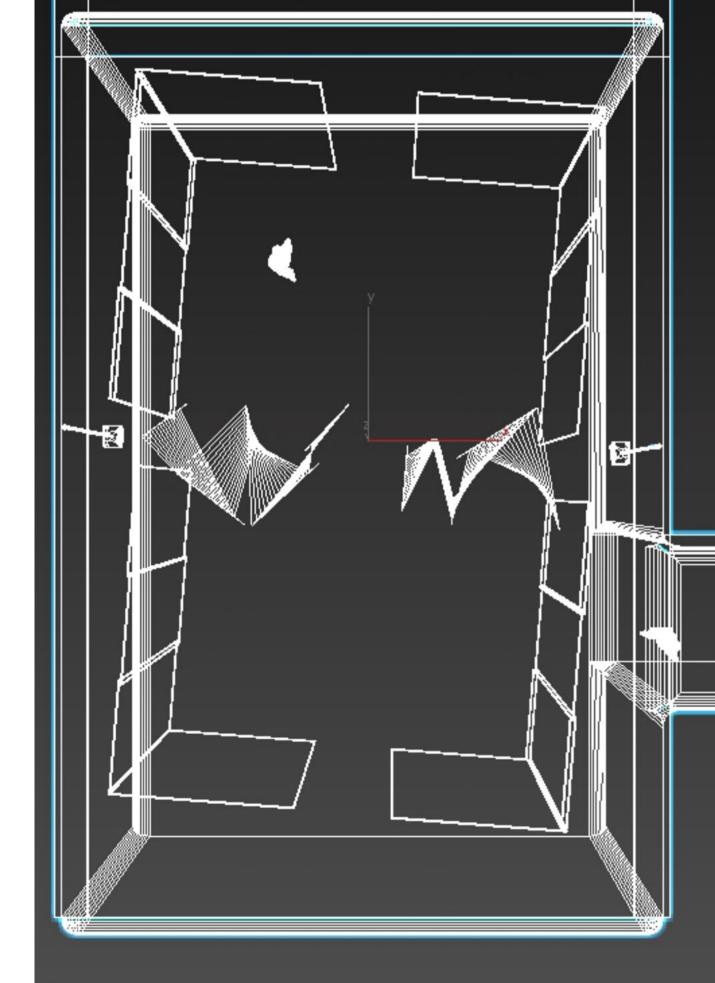
近年来郑重宾被越来越多的国际策展人和机构所熟悉。2015年4月,"零运动"学者Renate Wiehager(雷娜特.维哈格)将郑重宾的作品《白色的反射区》(2012)和德国著名艺术家马克斯.乌里克(Max Uhlig)的作品一同在柏林戴姆勒当代展馆展出。5月,郑重宾参加威尼斯双年展期间位于欧洲文化中心"个人结构:跨越边界"展,首次展出其环境影像作品《运行中的异化之景》(2015)。6月,在泰特现代美术馆前艺术总监李立偉(Lars Nittve)的推荐下,代表郑重宾八十年代以来艺术发展的八件作品被香港M+博物馆收藏。11月,洛杉矶郡艺术博物馆在郑重宾和罗伊·利希滕斯坦(Roy Lichtenstein)的双人展中展出了新藏品《乱》(2013)。2016年3月,大都会博物馆和布鲁克林美术馆分别收藏了郑重宾抽像作品《展开的风景》(2015)与《地平线》(2014)。当月郑重宾还以其环境装置作品《层层天牆》获"第11届上海双年展:何不在问"中策展人Raqs媒体小组评选为该展11位重点推荐艺术家之一。

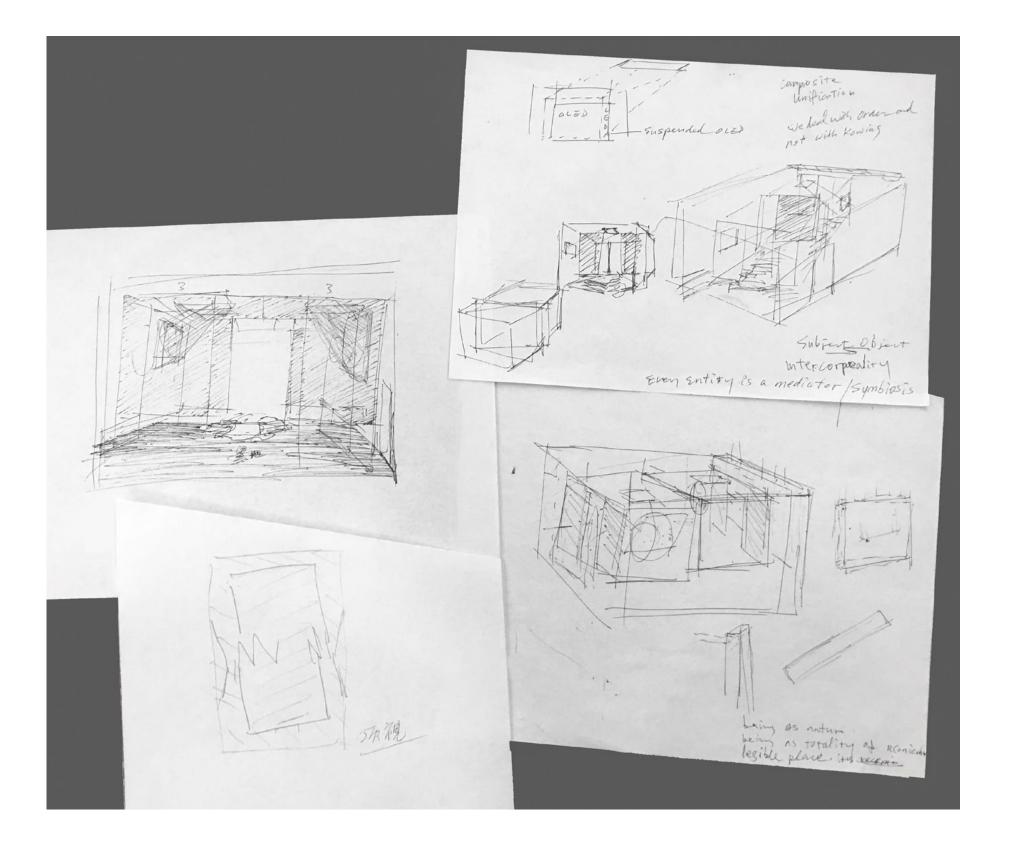

**行影支离** 2018 | Installation sketch 装置方案





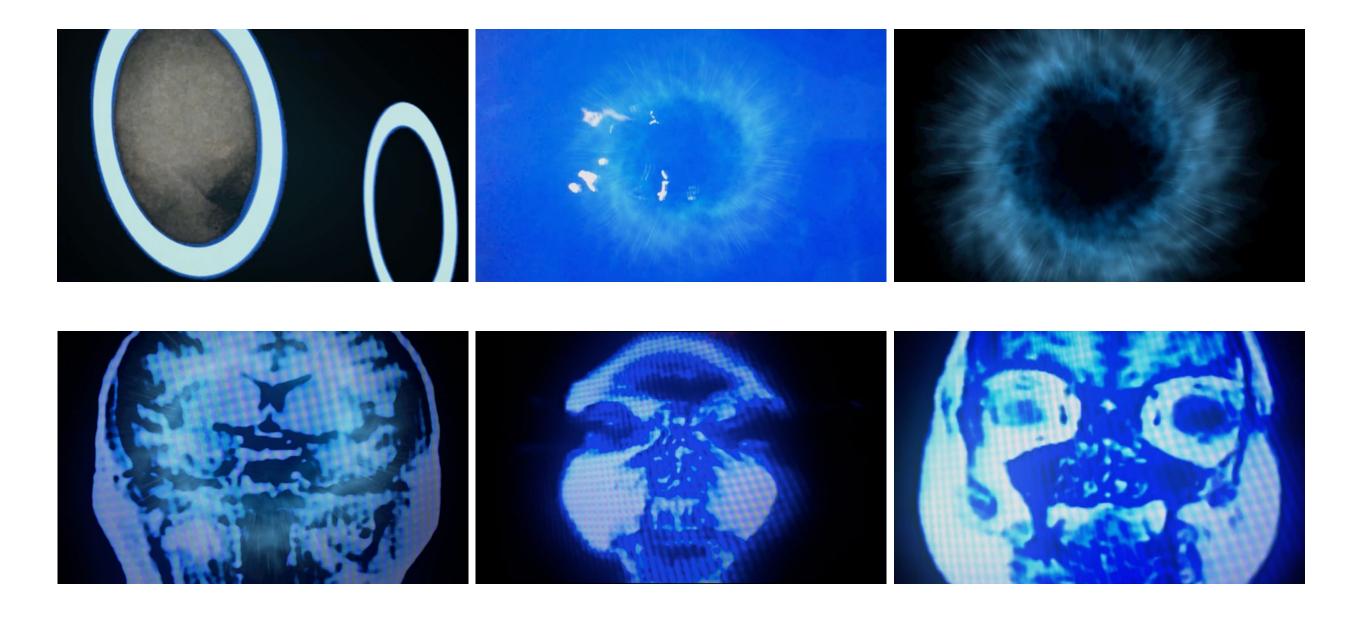

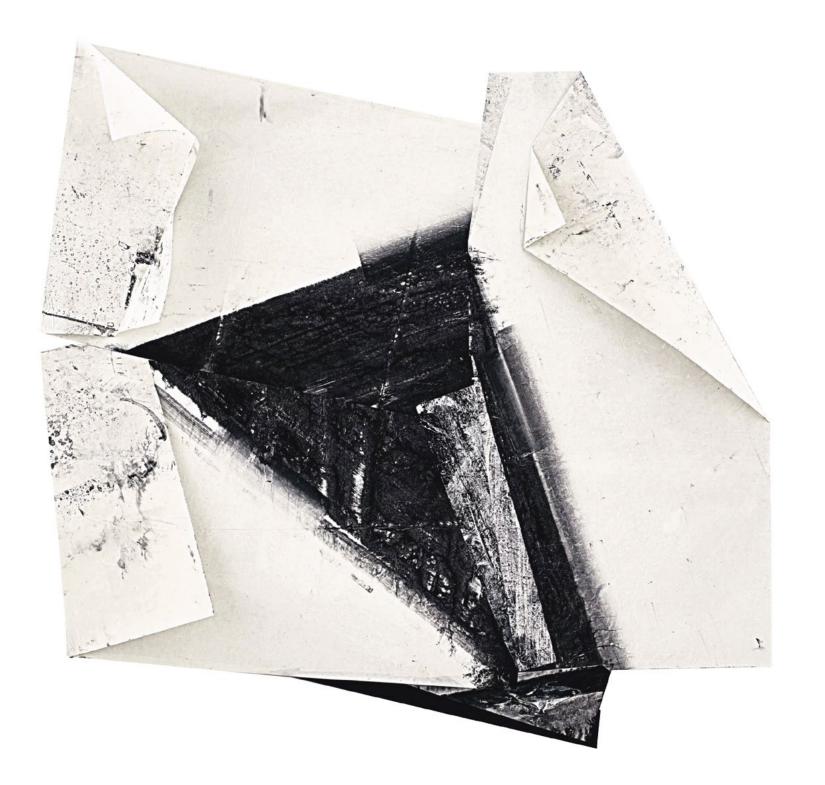

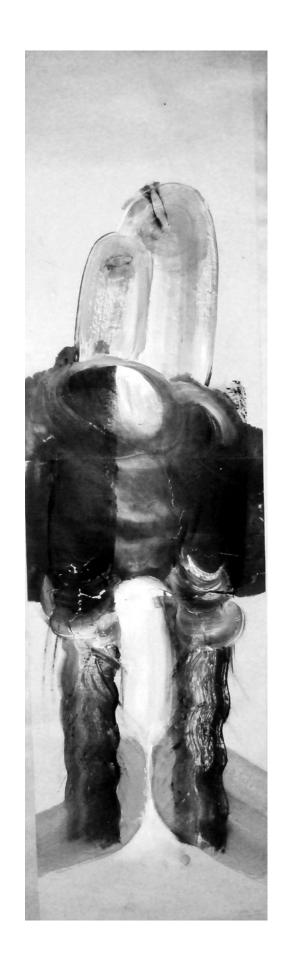
